I. AWARD DESCRIPTION

The number and monetary value scholarships will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee and Executive Board.

The Scholarship Committee and Executive Board will select the recipients of each scholarship.

The scholarship is renewable, however it must be applied for each semester or year as applicable.

II. APPLICANT'S/RECIPIENTS REQUIREMENTS

Recipient must register in an automotive related program of study in a recognized/certified school.

In addition to the applicant's high school grade point average (GPA), the Scholarship Committee and the Executive Board will preferentially consider the following:

- 1. Study in an automotive or technical field. To include, but not limited to, auto/truck mechanics and auto/truck body work.
- 2. Study at a vocational or technical school, two or four year college.
- 3. Recipients must have graduated from a high school in Oregon or Washington, or have been enrolled for at least one year in the college/technical school where they are currently enrolled.

III. PAYMENT AND PUBLICITY

Scholarship selection will be announced at the regular business meeting for the Pharaohs. As soon as an applicant has been approved awarded a scholarship

Recipient will allow the Pharaohs Street Rodders to use their name and image in any publicity announcing the scholarship or promoting the program.

The Pharaohs Street Rodders will issue a check for the scholarship amount agreed to, to the institution for the recipient's tuition as soon as he/she provides proof of registration at the school, and letter or form from the registrars office which shows proof of registration and classes attending for that given term.
